He went on to receive an engineering degree and an MBA from the University of Michigan. He worked several years for a Fortune 500 company, was engaged to be married, and yet God had other plans. He attended Franciscan University in Steubenville, Ohio, went on to Seminary, and entered the priesthood. Over the past several years he has spoken at over 100 parishes and is now the Director of the Marian Fathers of the Immaculate Conception where he serves as "Fr.
